

PROCEDURE LIST

SHAKESPEARE LESSON



Each lesson period:

- 1) Recite memory passage, half line by half line, twice together.
- 2) Ask each child (youngest to oldest) to name one character, or describe one character, or tell a favorite part so far to jog their memory.
- 3) Read/listen/discuss one of the following for 10-15 minutes at a time.
 - a. picture book
 - b. watch movie (can be done over a weekend)
 - c. listen to audiobook while following along with paperbacks
 - d. ask one question: i.e. "Was so-and-so right/mean/ambitious/good/wise?" or, "Did you like this play? Why, why not?" OR have them act out favorite bits themselves or with LEGO/DUPLO or Masterpuppets

One play, done this way, usually takes us 6-8 weeks.
